






Timeline

- Apr 2020 draft:
 - Continuing operation & management of Regional Cabled Array, Coastal Endurance & Pioneer Arrays, and Global Irminger & Papa Arrays
 - Continuing operation of existing CI & data delivery
 - Community engagement
- Anticipated new scope in Aug 2020 draft:
 - Development of upgraded hardware & network under leadership of new CI PI
 - Testing of new system
 - Phase-out of old system
 - Ongoing operation & management of new system
