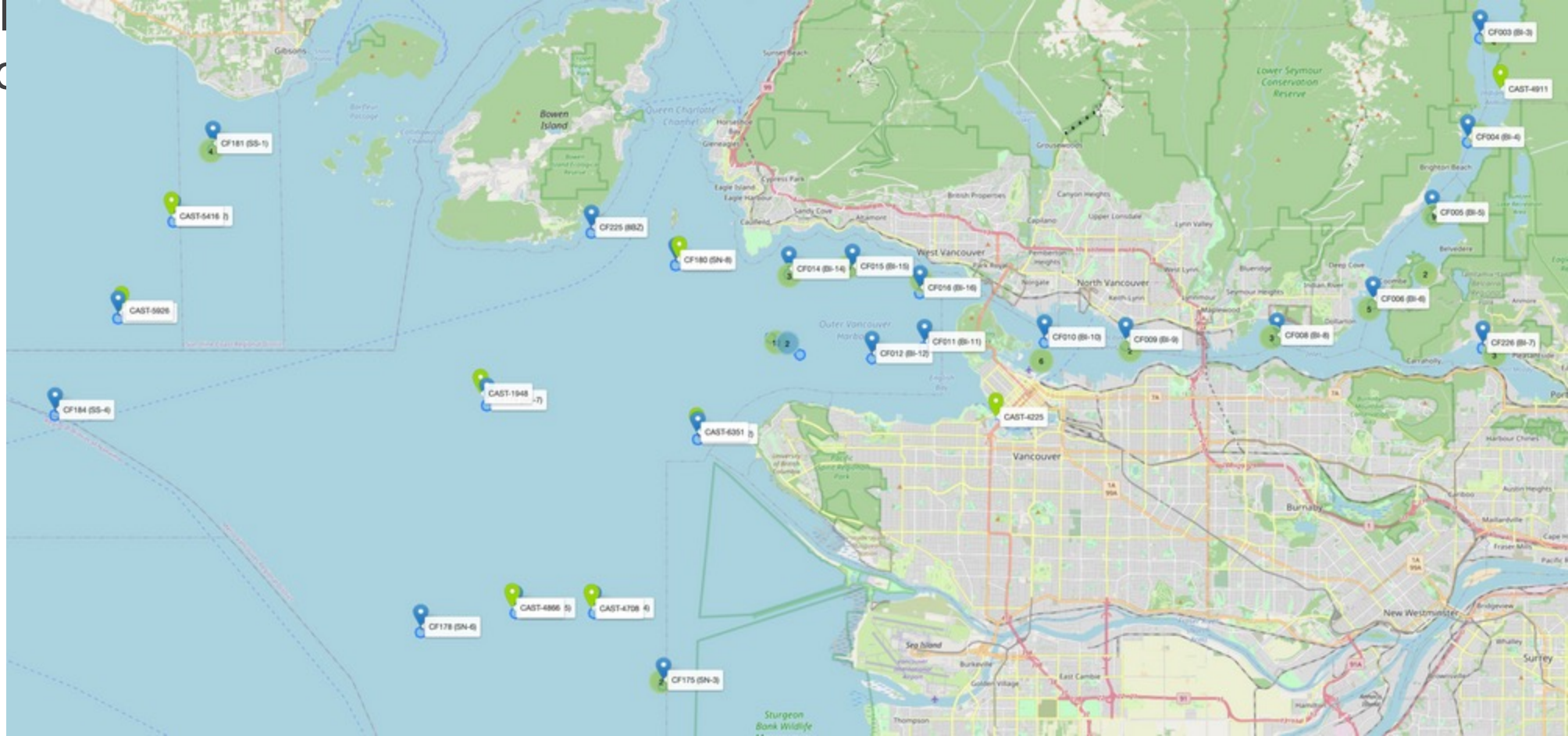
Ocean Networks Canada: Community Engagement and Education

ONC has a dedicated community engagement and education team, led by Dr. Maia Hoeberechts (+9 others). They engage and support community ocean observation programs across Canada, including an extensive indigenous first nations program, and a wide range of education and training (ocean literacy certificate) programs.



Ocean Networks Canada: Cabled and Remote Observatories

Community Fishers: An ocean CTD profile program, where community boat operators are provided with a CTD and tablet and regularly collect data at designated stations.

ONC runs an extensive ocean literacy and education programs, with K-12, University, and technology training (certificate) opportunities.
